




The Waits

Some of his songs are included in "Select Musically Ayres and Dialogues" (1653), but he is now known only by 'Here's a health unto his Majesty' and his four-part song 'The Waits', printed in Playford's "Musical Companion", by long-standing custom the last piece sung at the meeting of the Madrigal Society at their regular winter meetings in the City of London and similar bodies.
